Adam Mickiewicz University, Poznań applies the following system of grades awarded for examinations and credits:

- very good (*bardzo dobry; bdb; 5,0*),
- good + (*dobry plus; db plus; 4,5*),
- good (*dobry; db; 4,0*),
- satisfactory + (*dostateczny plus; dst plus; 3,5*),
- satisfactory (*dostateczny; dst; 3,0*),
- unsatisfactory (*niedostateczny; ndst; 2,0*).

The final grade for the studies is determined by the sum rounded to two decimal places: obtained by addition:

- 1) for studies where the student is required to submit a thesis:
  - a) of 3/5 of the arithmetic mean of all the grades obtained, rounded to two decimal places;
  - b) of 1/5 of the thesis grade being the arithmetic mean of the grades awarded by the supervisor and reviewer;
  - c) of 1/5 of the final grade of the final examination.
- 2) for studies where the student is not required to submit a thesis:

- a) of 3/4 of the arithmetic mean of all the grades obtained, rounded to two decimal places;
- b) of 1/4 of the final grade of the diploma examination.
- 3) in arts courses where the student is required to submit a thesis:
  - a) of 3/6 of the arithmetic mean of all the grades obtained, rounded to two decimal places;
  - b) of 1/6 of the grade for the thesis being the arithmetic mean of the grades awarded by the supervisor and the reviewer;
  - c) of 1/6 of the final grade of the final examination (theoretical part);
  - d) of 1/6 of the final grade of the final examination (artistic part).
- 4) in arts courses where the student is not required to submit a thesis:
  - a) of 4/6 of the arithmetic mean of all the grades obtained, rounded to two decimal places;
  - b) of 1/6 of the final grade for the final examination (theoretical part);
  - c) of 1/6 of the final grade of the final examination (artistic part).

The final grade entered into the diploma is arrived at in accordance with the following principle:

- 1) up to 3,40 – satisfactory (dostateczny);
- 2) more than 3,40 up to 3,80 – satisfactory + (dostateczny plus);
- 3) more than 3,80 up to 4,20 – good (dobry);
- 4) more than 4,20 up to 4,60 – good + (dobry plus);
- 5) more than 4,60 – very good (bardzo dobry).

Grades outside brackets are course grades, grades inside brackets are grades for the classes, vertical bar separates grades for various classes, semicolon separates grades on various exam reports, space separates grades on the same exam report, order of grades on a report follows order of exam sessions.

ZAL (zaliczenie) = non-graded pass, NZAL (niezaliczenie) = fail, — = no grade in the examination protocol.
